

2016 Event Pricing & Guidelines

Events at the Farmhouse:

- The fee for a wedding and/or reception at the Farmhouse is \$4000. Non wedding/hourly events are \$1000 plus \$300 per hour.
- For events hosting more than 50 people, you must hire an event planner.
- The maximum number of attendees is 120.
- Cardinal Point provides the outdoor space only; licensees will need to rent tents, chairs, tables, and portable toilets.



• The rental fee includes two nights stay at the Farmhouse. The house can accommodate up to 10 people, but we cannot allow access to the house for any additional event attendees.



- The maximum length of an event at the Farmhouse is 6 hours, and the event must end by 10:00 p.m.
- All music must end by 9:30 p.m., and volume is subject to owner discretion.

Events at the Winery:



- The fee for a wedding and/or reception at the Winery is \$2500.
 Non wedding/hourly events are \$250 per hour.
- For events hosting more than 50 people, you must hire an event planner.
- The maximum number of attendees is 120.
- Available rental space at the Winery includes the deck, patio, parts of the tasting room, the mezzanine, and two restrooms. The Winery floor is strictly offlimits.
- If your event hosts more than 50 people, you must rent portable toilets.
- Licensees at the Winery may make use of our seating and furniture, but may need to rent additional furniture and portable toilets depending on the nature and size of the event.
- Events at the Winery may not start until 6:00 p.m., and must end by 11:00 p.m.
- All music must end by 10:00 p.m., and the volume is subject to owner discretion.
